- 1. Removed signage at C-Dock entrance and various dock areas, and inspected the pier for necessary repairs before the opening.
- 2. Replaced the tire on the Kubota with a new one.
- 3. Investigated meters with unusually high readings for leaks and installed new meters where needed due to age.
- 4. Installed one-way signs at Riverview and a stop sign at Cooper Avenue, and replaced a pole at Cool Springs and Colorado that had been damaged.
- 5. Constructed shelves for the charging station of our cordless tools in the office area to keep them warm and extend their lifespan.
- 6. Cleared brush along Ogle Street where it was encroaching on the roadway.
- 7. Applied cold patch to potholes in Old Town, Baltimore Street, and other areas in town.
- 8. Plowed roads and spread salt on intersections, hills, icy spots, and areas around the post office, church, town hall, and the sidewalk in front of the firehouse as needed.
- 9. Shut down water service due to a leak and was on-site as required for the main water break at Cool Springs.
- 10. Removed Christmas wreaths from poles, took down the tree, and dismantled wreaths from the post office and ice house.
- 11. Conducted two brush pickups and bulk waste removals this month, and disposed of trash at parks four times.
