• Annual Report 2023

• Fire Sprinkler Ordinance Amendment

A note will be added regarding the International Residential Building Code, "as amended".

Resolution 2024-05

This Resolution was presented, which restores the authority of approving permits to the Zoning Administrator and Code Enforcement Officer, with exceptions for certain provisions. A motion to approve was made by Mr. Confalone, seconded by Ms. Rowe. Carried 4-0-1, with Commissioner Capano abstaining, who will vote later with the Town Commissioners.

• Discuss New Permit Fee structure

Mr. Hamilton presented the proposed fees. There was some discussion regarding the engineer's fee, and whether it should be a flat rate or custom fee, based on the project.
